Dear Ms. Gregory,

This letter is in reference to your letter submitted on behalf of the Clumber Spaniel Club of America (CSCA) requesting that the Clumber Spaniel be added to the list of breeds required to be judged on the ramp through all levels of conformation competition including Group and Best in Show judging at AKC conformation events.

As previously advised, this request would be presented to the AKC Board of Directors for review and determination consistent with procedures associated with requests for ramp mandatory designation.

I have been asked to inform you the Board did further consider this matter at its May 2020 meeting and it was its decision to approve the Clumber Spaniel Club of America's request to be assigned **ramp mandatory status effective September 1, 2020.**

Notification that the Clumber Spaniel must be judged on the ramp is required to be printed in all premium lists for shows on and after September 1, 2020 that offer conformation competition for the breed. In addition, the AKC Table/Ramp list will be revised to reflect the change of status and notice will be sent to all AKC conformation judges.
